

Recognition requirements for providers of Kinesiology

Please apply for recognition through your professional association

Our recognition requirements for natural therapy providers have been developed to ensure that services supplied to our members comply with the minimum standards set out in the PHI (Accreditation) Rules 2011 and our minimum education/training standards.

Natural therapists which includes kinesiologists must meet the following requirements to be recognised by HCF:

- Continuously hold a current Senior First Aid Certificate (or equivalent);
- Continuously hold a current Professional Indemnity insurance along with public and product liability insurance to a minimum value of \$1 million per claim for services provided to HCF members;
- Belong to a professional association that meets our recognition requirements at the appropriate level of membership and adheres to the association membership requirements
- Comply with [Terms and Conditions for HCF Recognised Providers of General Treatment](#) as amended from time to time.
- Meet our training and education requirements for the profession in which they seek recognition. (Providers who have been continuously recognised by HCF before 1 July 2009 are deemed to meet our training and education requirements).
